<p>The cost of a single hepatitis b vaccine is £30 per dose. A full course of hepatitis b is three individual vaccines, this comes to a total of £90.</p> <p>A blood test is required 6 weeks after completion of this course, the fee for the blood test and certificate confirming the result is £40.</p> <p>Please note that occasionally blood results show that you may need a 4th dose of the hepatitis vaccine, if this is the case then you will be charged an additional £30 which must be paid prior to the vaccine being given.</p> <p>If a 4th vaccine is required then you will also require another blood test. There is an additional £20 charge for this which must be paid prior to the test.</p>
